## **Press Note**

In order to control the frequent accidents on the Mumbai-Bangalore National Highway, an inquiry committee was constituted of Transport Branch, Project Director, National Highway Authority of India, Superintending Engineer, Public Works Board Pune Regional Transport Officer, Regional Transport Office, Pune. The said committee has conducted an inspection in the area between Katraj Bogda and Navale Bridge and has submitted a comprehensive report in which various measures have been suggested to prevent accidents.

Fatal and serious accidents on the Mumbai-Bangalore National Highway from Navin Katraj Tunnel to Navale Bridge are mainly caused by heavy/heavy vehicles. Paveto's study has shown that when heavy vehicles / heavy transport vehicles are speeding through the ghat, the braking system of the vehicle does not respond properly and the parent loses control of the vehicle. According to this, controlling the speed of vehicles has been discussed as a serious issue in the meetings held by the committee so far, and for that purpose, 40 km for vehicles carrying heavy / heavy traffic on this highway between Katraj Bogda and Navale Bridge. / hour has been unanimously suggested to fix the speed limit.

In order to prevent the said accident, it is necessary to bring the village control of the heavy vehicles plying through this area. For this, Government of Maharashtra Home Department No.MC. 20196/879/CR-30/TRA-2, dated 27/09/1996 in exercise of the powers vested in me under Sections 115 118(1) (2) (b), 118(4) and 157 of the Motor Vehicles Act Vijayakumar Magar, Deputy Commissioner of Police Transport, Pune City, for all types of heavy vehicles (tractor-trailer combination truck-trailers, articulated vehicles, multi-axle vehicles, containers, large goods vehicles) plying between the tunnel and bridge on the Mumbai-Bangalore National Highway. vehicles) on experimental basis as follows. 19/05/2023 at 00:01 2400 th on 25/05/2023. Issuing speed limit orders as follows.

## **Emergency Order**

40 km/s for all types of heavy, heavy vehicles (tractor-trailer combination, truck-trailer, articulated or multi-axle vehicles, containers, large goods vehicles) plying between Katraj Tunnel and Namle Bridge on the Mumbai Bangalore National Highway. Hourly speed limit is being fixed.

However, if citizens have any suggestions in this regard, then Deputy Commissioner of Police Control Branch, Bungalow No. 6. In the office of Jail Road, Yerwada, Pune dt. On 26/05/2023 11.00 hrs. By considering the suggestions and objections of citizens in written form Final order excluding essential service vehicles (eg ambulance, fire brigade, police vehicles). will be removed.
